



Unite For Sight: Eye Health for Teachers

Instructions for Chapters:

Each chapter of Unite For Sight is required to do a minimum of one outreach presentation per month to a group of teachers at a local school. Before the presentation begins, you should ask each teacher to complete the “Eye Health for Teachers Pre-Test” which can be printed from the Chapter Manual section of the Unite For Sight website. After the presentation is complete, you should then ask the teachers to complete the “Eye Health for Teachers Post-Test,” also available for printing from the same location on the website.

These tests are identical, but it is important that you print them separately. The tests are marked with different footers so that you can easily tell between the tests when you are grading them later. The tests include 12 multiple choice questions. **These tests are an important part of our effort to track the effectiveness of this program.** After the tests are completed, please use the answer key below to grade each test and enter the scores in the “Eye Health Teachers Score Report” excel file on the Chapter Manual website. Then, email this completed sheet within 1-week of the school program to rturkel@uniteforsight.org **This email should include “Eye Health Teachers Score Report” as the subject line.**

A quick checklist:

- 1) Introduce yourself as a Unite For Sight Community Fellow and explain the purpose of the presentation
- 2) Ask teachers to complete pre-test
- 3) Give presentation. You will train teachers to identify potential visual difficulties among their students (i.e. squinting, difficulty reading, difficulty seeing chalkboard), and you will also teach the teachers to link students and their families with free health coverage programs (i.e. CHIP, VisionUSA, EyeCare America)
- 4) Ask teachers to complete post-test
- 5) Grade both pre-test and post-test
- 6) Add grades to the Score Report
- 7) Email completed Score Report to rturkel@uniteforsight.org
