While receiving hands-on training in public health programs, you will gain skills to become a new leader in public health. Community Fellows experience the thrill of contributing to change on the highest level. They are trained to reduce barriers to care by serving as advocates for community members. They educate about the importance of receiving regular eye exams to prevent blindness and connect community members with resources so that they can receive a complete eye exam through professional organizations such as American Academy of Ophthalmology (EyeCare America) and American Optometric Association (VisionUSA). By connecting community members with available free eye care by eye care professionals, the Community Fellows are helping community members to eliminate preventable blindness.
